



Forming the ambitious centrepiece of **York Mediale 2020**, this exciting and innovative exhibition explores human nature and the separation between bodies, our environment and technology.

Fresh from their show at the Saatchi Gallery, London, **Marshmallow Laser Feast** present *The Tides Within Us*, exploring the journey of oxygen from lungs to the heart and body in a series of installations that echo the ecosystem within nature. Inspired by the collection at York Art Gallery, **Rachel Goodyear** premieres *Limina*, a new animation, accompanied by intricate works on paper. Completing the triptych, **Kelly Richardson's** hyperreal video installation *Embers and the Giants* makes its UK premiere.
